Director Paz was not present at this governing board meeting. Director Lopez provided an update on the lease negotiations with New Hope Church as the first site of the Matrix for Success Academy; it was reported that a lease agreement is close as the cost of securing Conditional Use Permit (CUP) is negotiated to be included. Director Lopez indicated that administrators for the Matrix have started and will be going through a two week on-boarding covering the DP model, Matrix petition and Competency Based education. Mr. Lopez again discussed the inclusion of data from NWEA showing academic progress schoolwide and within significant subgroups; this multi-year data will be included within LCAP goals for APEX.

Mr. Lopez spent time describing to the board the preparation taking place for the upcoming LAUSD oversight visit this week (April 26), highlighting the progress made across all grade levels within NWEA testing; while proficiency level remain low, growth is observed across all grade levels and all significant subgroups. Mr. Lopez also discussed that fiscal picture will be enhanced in the positive as the Facilities Incentives grant for APEX and the PCSGP grant for Matrix go through and are incorporated into both school budgets in the next couple months.

Ayanthy Peiris from ExEd, provided the financial dashboard and reviewed the statements for February 2018. Director Lopez affirmed that with the P 2 report submitted, revenue for the 1st half of 2018-19 will reflect revenue based on ADA 362 versus ADA 342 durinf current yaer, an improvement of 20 ADA. Mr. Lopez also again explained that partial salaries of directors and operations manager will continue to be shifted to Matrix account as more work and activity is directed toward the Matrix start-up.
